

MoKi Coordinator Job Description

SLV LOCAL FOODS COALITION Local Foods Local Places (LFLP) initiative seeks a part-time, seasonal mobile kitchen “MOKI” Coordinator. This position is responsible for coordinating local-food based meals prepared and served from the SLV Local Foods Coalition Food Truck or Mobile Kitchen known as the “MoKi”. This is a seasonal position and has shifts on Thursdays, Fridays and Saturdays as well as weekly meetings and reporting to the Local Foods Local Places Program Director. The Coordinator will serve both the Monte Vista Farmers Market which starts in July and runs for 12 weeks on Fridays from 9am to 1pm and the Alamosa Farmers market which begins in July and runs for 14 weeks from 8am to 1pm on Saturdays. There will also be special events at times The Moki Coordinator will prepare and serve healthy meals utilizing in-season local products. They will recruit volunteer chefs and local cooks. They will educate about Why Local is important and How to do it using LFLP materials.
